Full-time Tenure Track Instructor of Romance Languages

The College is currently searching for an Instructor of Romance Languages within the College's Humanities & Social Sciences Division. Under the general supervision of the Associate Dean of Humanities & Social Sciences, the Instructor of Romance Languages is responsible for teaching 15 credits per semester of day, evening and weekend classes, maintaining office hours, providing advisement for students, participating in curriculum development/review, textbook selection, and student learning outcomes assessment; and participating in division and college-wide committees and professional development activities.

Requirements: The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of the mission of an urban community college and have experience working with a culturally diverse community. Demonstrable knowledge of pedagogical technology, strong interpersonal and communication skills. Demonstrated ability to provide diverse teaching methods to different learning styles. Must be able to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds. Master's Degree in Romance Languages or closely related discipline from a regionally accredited institution of higher education, as well as a minimum of three years of teaching experience (preferably at the community college level). Priority given to those able to teach both Spanish and French. Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts and to provide a teaching demonstration. Experience in distance education. Proficiency with various computer software programs, assessment software such as WEAVE, and the use of Ellucian-Colleague or similar higher education platform preferred.
