

## **Instructor of Business/Economics**

Hudson County Community College is an award-winning, comprehensive urban college located just across the Hudson River from Manhattan in Jersey City and Union City, NJ. Fully accredited by Middle States Commission on Higher Education, the College offers courses and classes in a wide variety of disciplines to the people and businesses of Hudson County, one of the most historic and ethnically diverse areas of the United States. The College was recognized with the 2012 Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) Northeast Regional Equity Award, was one of just five finalists in the U.S. for the American Association of Community Colleges' (AACC) Student Success Award, and was presented with the New Jersey Business & Industry Association's Good Neighbor Awards in 2009 for the Culinary Arts Conference Center and in 2012 for the North Hudson Campus Project, and in 2015 for the Library Building.

The college seeks an experienced Instructor of Business/Economics. Reporting to the Associate Dean of the Business, Culinary and Hospitality division, the Instructor of Business is responsible for teaching 15 credits per semester, both day and evening classes in business and economic disciplines; participating in division activities such as curriculum development, academic assessment, and academic advisement; and contributing to the College community through committee work or other extracurricular activities. This is a full-time, tenure track position.

Requirements: Master's degree in Management, Business Administration or Economics. Higher education (preferably community college) teaching or related training experience preferred. Demonstrable knowledge of pedagogical technology, strong interpersonal and communication skills providing diverse teaching methods to different learning styles. Must be able to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural and ethnic backgrounds. Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts and to provide a teaching demonstration. The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of and commitment to the role of a comprehensive community college in an urban, multi-cultural setting.

**Preferred**: Experience in distance education. Proficiency with various computer software programs and the use of Ellucian-Colleague (formerly Datatel) or similar higher education platform. 1-3 years of college-level teaching is preferred for all full-time faculty positions at HCCC.
