



INSTRUCTOR OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

Hudson County Community College is an award-winning, comprehensive urban college located just across the Hudson River from Manhattan in Jersey City and Union City, NJ. Fully accredited by Middle States Commission on Higher Education, the College offers courses and classes in a wide variety of disciplines to the people and businesses of Hudson County, one of the most historic and ethnically diverse areas of the United States. The College was recognized with the 2012 Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) Northeast Regional Equity Award, was one of just five finalists in the U.S. for the American Association of Community Colleges' (AACC) Student Success Award, and was presented with the New Jersey Business & Industry Association's Good Neighbor Awards in 2009 for the Culinary Arts Conference Center and in 2012 for the North Hudson Campus Project, and in 2015 for the Library Building.

The College is currently searching for an Instructor of Environmental Studies within the College's STEM Division. Under the general supervision of the Associate Dean of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics, the Instructor of Environmental Studies is responsible for teaching at least 15 credits per semester of day, evening, and weekend classes in Geology and Environmental Studies; participating in division activities such as curriculum development and academic advisement; and contributing to the College community through committee work or other extracurricular activities. This is a full-time, ten-month position.

The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of the mission of an urban community college and be able to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds. Candidates must demonstrate knowledge of educational technology, have strong interpersonal and communication skills, and be able to employ diverse teaching methods for different learning styles.

Requirements: A Master's degree in Geology, Environmental Science, Ecology, or a closely related field from a regionally accredited institution of higher education, as well as a minimum of three years of teaching experience (preferably at the community college level) is required. Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts and to provide a teaching demonstration. Experience in distance education and proficiency with various computer software programs is preferred.
