



Youth Program Behavior Expectations

Student Behavior Expectations in the classroom:

- Students will respect each other's ideas, suggestions, and comments.
- Students will work independently when asked by the teacher with guided instruction.
- Students will be able to work cooperatively in group settings, without disrupting the teacher or classmates.
- Students will respect the property of others and will show additional care with all of the manipulatives and other classroom tools.

Students may be excluded from activities or dismissed from the program if they do not adhere to the Program Expectations. The following are examples for immediate dismissal:

- Persist on disrupting the classroom environment after several teacher warnings
 1. First Warning –Verbal
 2. Second Warning –Written
 3. Dismissal with no refund
- Jeopardize the safety or health of other children by threatening or bullying
- Steal or vandalize property of Hudson County Community College or the property of others
- Leave assigned areas on his or her own without receiving written permission from the classroom teacher or teacher assistant
